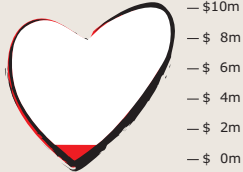

Team Villa came to be in 2008 when two very proud Italo-Canadians, Pino Correale and Frank Ciccolini Jr. – both seasoned marathoners, walked into Villa Foundation's office and said they would like to do something different to help raise funds for Villa Foundation. Team Villa's inaugural voyage to the 2009 Rome Marathon was a huge success.

Today, Team Villa has almost doubled in size and has become an annual destination sporting event where runners participate in a different marathon across Italy each year. 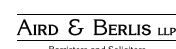
