WHAT IS THE MARIA DI SALVO AWARD?

The award is named in honour of Maria Di Salvo, the first resident of Villa Colombo Vaughan admitted October 30, 2006.

This award will be given to recognize staff, physicians, service providers or managers who, in caring for residents consistently demonstrate compassionate care, superior customer service and are considered a positive role model for other colleagues.

Two awards of \$500 each will be available each fiscal year. Winners will also be awarded a recognition plaque and the recipient's name will be displayed on a plaque located at Villa Colombo Vaughan.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Any resident, family, staff, physician, volunteer and/or manager may complete a nomination form. Nominations must be received in writing. Once nominations are received they will be verified and screen for eligibility; this will include a reference from the nominee's manager. There are no restrictions.

In addition to the written nomination, letters commendations, compliments and cards set in by residents and their families are reviewed in order to substantiate the nomination.

Applications will be received throughout the year. Nominations will be forwarded to the Chair of the Maria Di Salvo Compassionate Care Selection committee.
