Here's what you can expect when we reopen our facilities:



- Increased cleaning throughout all facilities, including cleaning of equipment and physical spaces between classes and activities.



- All patrons / visitors are encouraged to self-assess and if they display any symptoms, refrain from entering any building on the Villa Charities campus and adhere to Public Health Guidelines.



- Increase in the number of personal hand sanitization stations.

- The use of personal face masks is encouraged.
- All employees will have access to PPE.



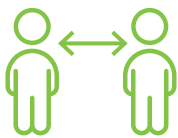
- Building entry and exit points will be limited.
- When entering and exiting or making your way through the facility please keep to the right.



- All staff will conduct a self-assessment prior to coming to work and if they display any symptoms, they must follow Public Health Guidelines and self-isolate.



- Operating at 50% capacity and/or in a fashion that complies with physical distancing guidelines.



- Face-to-face meetings and interactions must respect physical distancing guidelines. Interactions through phone calls, e-mails, video conferencing, etc. are strongly recommended.



- Access to classes, programs, services, etc. will be by appointment only, no drop-ins will be allowed.



- There will be no internal waiting / seating areas.
- Selected amenities will not be available including changerooms.



- Floor markings will be visible throughout the facilities to support physical distancing.
- Protective barriers have been installed in key public / staff-facing areas.



- Payment will only be through debit or credit cards.

Anyone found violating any of the health and safety measures and potentially creating a health risk for another individual will be asked to leave the facility.
