



Important Update
COVID – 19 Outbreak
October 11, 2022

Dear VCV Residents, Families and Staff,

York region Public Health has declared a **Confirmed Outbreak** for our home due to new staff and residents' active cases. Only affected residents and close contacts were placed on isolation under contact/droplet precautions.

As of October 11, 2022, at 3:00 PM

Staff		Active Cases – 2
Residents		Active Cases – 5

We will be testing residents as per risk assessment and YRPH recommendations on the following dates:

Please speak to unit charge nurse if you have questions regarding your loved one's isolation, testing or test results.

We continue to work closely and collaboratively with York Region Public Health in managing this outbreak and will provide updates as they become available to us.

Residents under isolation:

- Essential visitors are permitted, only (1) essential caregiver may visit at a time
- **General visitors are not permitted**

The following IPAC measures are in place:

- Increased cleaning of high-touch surfaces such as handrails and furniture in all areas
- Close monitoring of all residents for symptoms of COVID-19, including taking temperatures and completing active screening
- Active screening of all staff and visitors
- Co-horting of staff
- Physical distancing is maintained in all areas of the home
- Enhanced hand hygiene
- Enhanced surveillance testing of staff and visitors

Please remain vigilant and practice the following measures to minimize the spread of the virus:

- Stay 6 feet apart from others
- Avoid crowds
- Wear a mask
- Stay home and self-isolate if you are sick
- Clean surfaces and your hands often
- Avoid touching your face
- Pay attention to and sanitize surfaces while shopping or using a gas station
- Open windows to increase airflow and ventilation
- DO NOT come to the Home if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19
- Adhere to all home's Policies, Government of Ontario and Public Health Directives
- Get vaccinated against COVID-19, schedule your booster shot



- **If you haven't done so already, book your COVID-19 vaccination or booster shot.** Health Canada approved the **Moderna / Spikevax COVID-19 bivalent vaccine** which offers more targeted protection against the Omicron variants.
